In May 2010, he received an MA in Professional Counseling from Amridge University and is a licensed professional counselor (LPC). He worked as the associate minister at the Barrackville Church of Christ in Barrackville, WV. Since November 1999, he has served as one of the ministers at the Fairview Church of Christ in Fairview, WV (formerly known as the Washington Street Church of Christ). From 2005 to 2014, he made annual mission trips to India, spending 5-6 weeks preaching the Gospel and teaching in preacher training schools.
